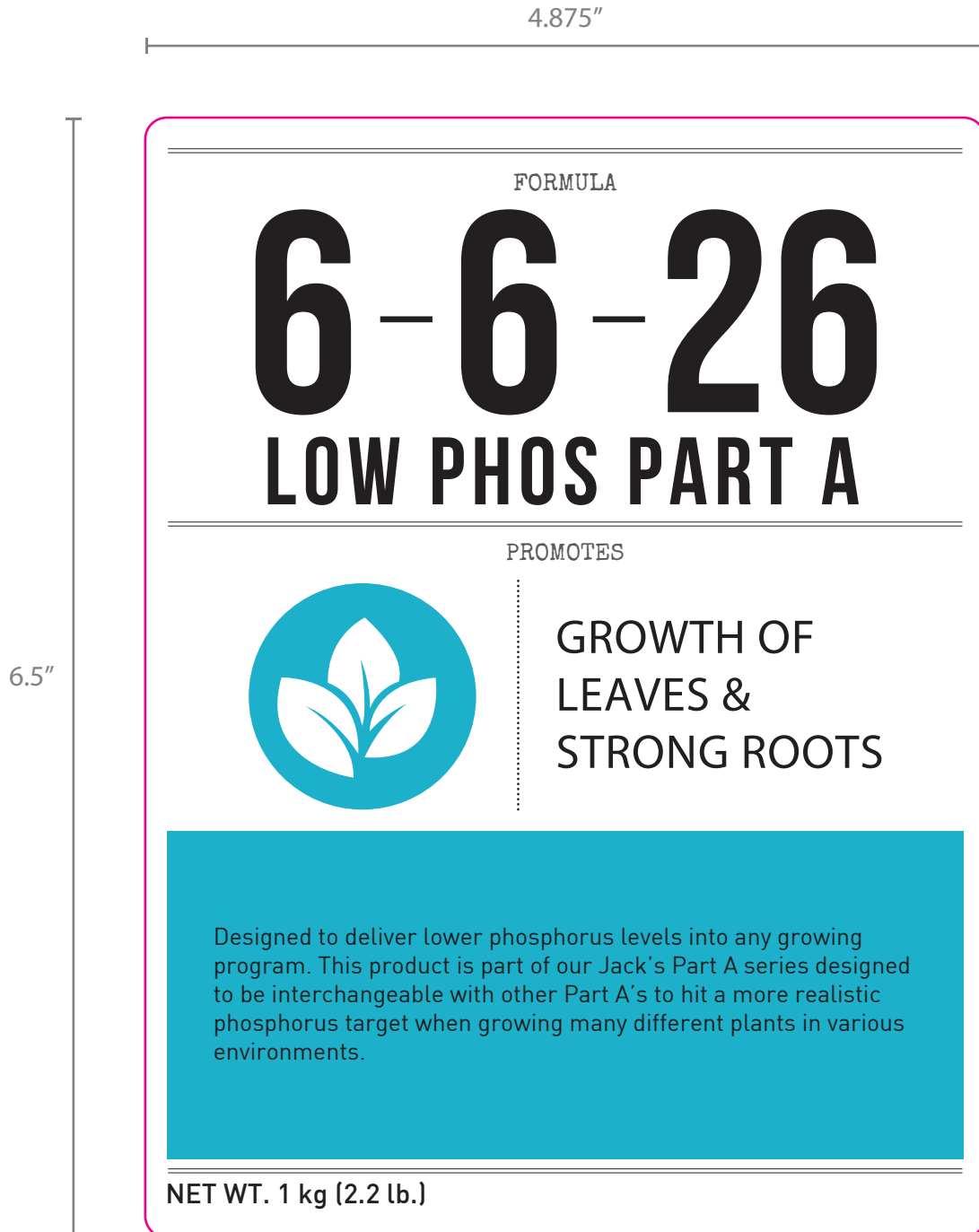

MIXING TIPS FOR AN EC OF 0.90 (50 PPM N)

1 GALLON
CONCENTRATE

FOR INJECTORS
AT 1:100:

Mix 11 dry ounces of
fertilizer per gallon
of stock

1 GALLON
READY TO USE

SMALL VOLUME
MIXING:

Mix 3.15 grams per
gallon of water as a
constant liquid feed

FOR A
LARGE SOLUTION
RESERVOIR:

Mix 11 dry ounces of
fertilizer in 100 gallons
of water as a constant
liquid feed

*USEFUL CONVERSIONS:
1 GAL = 3.78 L
1 TSP. = 5 GM

FOR A CONTINUOUS LIQUID FEED PROGRAM

Mix each part separately before combining together as a true solution.
BE AWARE: Mixing Part A and Part B together at high concentrations will result in a messy precipitate — some things just can't go together in the fertilizer world — if this happens, dump and start again. Also, oxygen levels are important in any nutrient solution — maintain adequate O₂ levels by aerating with a bubbler or changing solutions on a regular basis.
